**Present:** Bob Anderson and George McCusker. Neal Huntoon was absent.

Bob called the meeting to order at 7:05 p.m.

**Minutes:** George moved to approve the July 25, 2006 minutes as written, seconded by Bob and unanimously approved.

**Old Business:** The raft has been repaired and put back in place.

**New Business:**

Jennifer Mars and Scott Hatch from the NE Association of Four Wheel Drive Club met with the Board to discuss their organization. Their association works closely with landowners, towns, and 4WD owners to promote legal off-road driving, on public rights of way that are open and private land with landowner permission. Their organization is prepared to install bridges, and other maintenance necessary to keep roads open for responsible use, as well as emergency access. They also have a safety patrol program and educational programs for 4WD operators.

**Recreation Field:**

Sean Lyon met to update the Board on the recreation field project and fund raising. The field still needs to be surface coated and lined basketball stanchions installed, and fenced. They are holding off on equipment for the skateboard park until the final amounts are known to complete the field. Several fundraising events are planned for the fall and winter months. They plan to work on future mapping and potential costs for future use. They are working on setting up a friend's of the park program.

Sullivan District 2 Representatives Arthur Jillette, Peter Franklin, and write-in candidate Melanie Bell met with the Board.

**Miscellaneous Business:**

The Board reviewed YTD Treasurer's report and budget expenditures.

Bob reviewed draft of closing procedures for the NH/VT Solid Waste District.

**Day Camp:** The two-week day camp program is in its second successful week of operation. 15 children attended the first week, and 31 children the second week. The Board will send a letter of appreciation to Jim Tucker. Jim will be contacting the Selectmen regarding proposal for next year's session.

The Board was reminded of the August 23, 2006 court date regarding the Sanborn Hill Road issue.

**Correspondence:**

The Board reviewed a letter received from Officer, Michael Beaulieu regarding his safety concerns. The concerns will be taken into consideration for future planning.

Information reviewed from Emergency Management Director, Frank Anderson regarding Hazard Mitigation Planning. This will be further investigated.
