The following are to be considered draft minutes only until approved by the Board at their next meeting.

Present: Bob Anderson and Neal Huntoon. George McCusker was absent.

The meeting was called to order at 7:10 p.m.

The Board approved the purchase of wreaths from the Recreation Facility Fundraising Committee for the town buildings.

The Board reviewed a purchase order for the rescue department. The Board agreed to hold the request until next meeting for further review with Fire and Rescue.

The Board reviewed year-to-date expenditures and worked on proposed budget requests for Conservation, Patriotic Purposes, Library, Recreation Summer Camp, Welfare, Health and Hospital, Water Testing, Sanitation and Street Lighting. Information needs to be obtained from the NL-Springfield Water Precinct for hydrant maintenance, and from the Sunapee Transfer Station.

The Board discussed the previous request for a trailer for hauling lawn mowers and would like to be able to investigate the purchase of a used trailer. The Board did not approve the purchase of a new riding lawn mower, but would like to see the zero turn mower used more.

Neal and Bob agreed that they would like to work on wages at the next meeting.

A preliminary Budget Committee meeting is being scheduled for December 5, 2006.

Literature: Bob reviewed literature regarding the dissolution of the NH/VT Solid Waste District. He will get in touch with TJ Alexander to discuss the decisions that were reached while he was away.

The Board voted to adjourn at 9:00 p.m.
